

The Village Hall was opened in 1894 and since that time it has seen many people pass through its doors. The idea is to make an archive of the hall's history, its people and events. We are also asking for volunteers to come along and help collect stories as well scan documents and put this knowledge and documentation in some form of collection. Copies of everything will be recorded and stored at the Northumberland Archive to be available for anyone to view now and in the future.

We have tiles coming off the wall in our toilets and are looking for a repair or replacement


Project 4: Computer replacement


